INTRODUCTION

This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the scripture readings of 5th Sunday of Easter.

HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 5th Sunday of Easter.

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we have gathered here in the name of Jesus. Lord Jesus, you are the vine that nourishes us with new life so that we may bear good fruit in our lives. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Peace, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read John 15: 1-8. Then, as a family reflect on the questions given below and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

<u>Time of reflection and response:</u>

Today, we are invited to recognise our close relationship with God, the Father and Jesus, His Son. Jesus compares his relationship with his disciples to the relationship between a vine and the branches that grow on it. Through the image of the vine and the branches, Jesus invites us to be united closely to Him.

Jesus is also telling us that the very core of our existence is to be connected with him. He invites us to 'abide', to rest, to stay, to remain in him, so that his divine life flows in and through us. Jesus abides in us, and we are invited to abide in him, so that we can produce abundant fruit. We are the branches, and if we allow the life of the vine free reign in us, it will bear much fruit of patience, kindness, compassion and forgiveness.

As Christians, we have to take time to realise how much we have to be connected with Jesus so that we may receive life from him just as a great branch from the vine. Let us pray for the desire of a deeper relationship with Jesus, and for a fruitful life.

- What does it mean for me personally to know that I am as much a part of Jesus as the branch is a part of the vine?
- What does it mean for my own life that the life and power of Jesus flows into me and nourishes me? Are there things in my life that I would do differently if I consciously realised this?
