INTRODUCTION

This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the scripture readings of 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time.

WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 14^{th} Sunday of Ordinary Time

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of each one gathered here in your presence today. Help us to always recognise and accept Jesus as the Lord of our lives. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Peace, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read 2 Corinthians 12, 7-10 and Mark 6: 1-6. Then, as a family reflect on the commentary given below and share your responses to the questions with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

Time of reflection and response:

In his letter to the Corinthians, Paul speaks about a "thorn in the flesh". Usually, a 'thorn in the flesh' is some sort of physical infirmity or limitation. It is a problem or a difficulty an individual may have, which inhibits him/her in certain ways. We do not know what Paul's 'thorn in the flesh' was, but he referred to it as 'a messenger from Satan' which was designed to torment him. However, he further explained that his 'thorn in the flesh' was necessary. to keep him from exalting himself, and becoming proud. Like all of us, Paul needed a constant reminder of his own weakness... his inabilities and his utter dependence upon the Lord.

1. Is there an area in my own life that I consider to be a "thorn in the flesh? In what way does it inhibit me? What is God saying to me through this "thorn in the flesh"?

Even after all the miracles of healing which Jesus worked, he still was not accepted even in his own town. As he taught in the synagogue there his hearers were amazed that this ordinary man whom they knew as the carpenter could attain such wisdom. And they rejected him. It was difficult for the people of Jesus' town to imagine that he had a wisdom and the divine power that might be of benefit to them.

2. How open am I to listening or seeking wisdom from people whom I am familiar with, especially family members, friends or those whom I meet or see daily?

Lord, I pray that I may recognise your presence in the ordinary encounters of my day, and in people I know or meet daily. Help me notice the ways through which you desire to nourish me and give me life
