#### **INTRODUCTION**

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of  $18^{\text{th}}$  Sunday of Ordinary Time

#### **OPENING PRAYER**

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of each one gathered here in your presence today. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for bringing us the gift of life and faith. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Peace, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



#### **SCRIPTURE REFLECTION**

Invite someone to read John 6:24-35. Then, as a family reflect on the questions given below and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

#### Time of reflection and response:

The crowds went to Capernaum looking for Jesus; but he saw that they came to him because he had given them bread to eat. He said to them, "Work for the lasting food which gives eternal life."

What am I looking for in life? What is the food that God gives me every day?

The Jews then asked him, "What is the work that God wants us to do?" And Jesus answered them, "The work God wants is for you to believe in the One he sent."

What is the work that God wants me to do? What does he ask of me today?

They said, "Show us signs that we may see and believe you. Give us bread from heaven to eat."

Do I truly believe that God will provide for me, especially during this difficult time? What is the bread that I am asking for today?

Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall never be hungry and whoever believes in me shall never thirst."

During this pandemic, when I am unable to receive the Eucharist, what can I do to remain close to Jesus, the bread of life?

Jesus tells us that He is the One sent by the Father, the true bread that will give us eternal life. He asks us to believe in Him and to trust in God's love and care for us. Today, we remember His promise and trust that we will always find what we need when we turn to Him.

#### Say together as a family:

"Lord Jesus, you came down from heaven that we might have life in your name. You ask us to believe and to put our hope in you. We know that you love us and watch over us always. May we continue to grow in our faith and follow you, especially in times of trouble."


