INTRODUCTION

This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the scripture readings of 26th Sunday of Ordinary Time. We are also encouraged to spend some time praying for children and families who have been torn apart by wars, disasters and poverty this Sunday, the World Day of Migrants and Refugees. In addition, we will be celebrating the Feast of the Holy Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael this Wednesday, 29th September.

HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 26th Sunday of Ordinary Time.

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of each one gathered here in your presence today. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for bringing us the gift of life and faith. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Peace, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read **Mark 9: 38-41**. Then, as a family reflect on the questions given below and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

Time of reflection and response:

John, one of the disciples, told Jesus that they had seen someone drive out demons in his name and tried to stop him, because he was not one of them.

How do I feel about the good works done by others? Am I jealous and doubtful of their intentions, or willing to support their efforts for the good of all people?

Jesus told them not to stop others from working miracles in his name. "For whoever is not against us is for us."

What did Jesus mean when he said this? Was it important for Jesus that he and his disciples were the best and only miracle workers around?

He also told them that anyone who gives them even a drink of water just because they belong to him would be rewarded.

What does it mean to belong to Christ? How will I recognize those who belong to him?

Today, Jesus invites us to see people in a different way. He reminds us that there are no divisions in the kingdom of God, no 'us against them', and shows us that what is truly important is not fame or prestige, but the building of God's Kingdom on earth. We pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, that we may be able to open our hearts to others with understanding and respect.

Say together as a family:

"Lord Jesus, you came down from heaven that we might have life in your name. You ask us to believe and to put our hope in you. We know that you love us and watch over us always. May we continue to grow in our faith and follow you, especially in times of trouble."
