INTRODUCTION

This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the scripture readings of 31st Sunday of Ordinary Time. In today's reading, Jesus answers a question about the greatest commandment of all. We also celebrate All Saints Day and All Souls Day this week, which is a good time for us to remember the holy men and women who pray for us, as well as our family and friends who have gone before us and need our prayers.

HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of $31^{\rm st}$ Sunday of Ordinary Time.

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of each one gathered here in your presence today. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for bringing us the gift of life and faith. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Peace, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read **Mark 12: 28-34**. Then, as a family reflect on the questions given below and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

Time of reflection and response:

A teacher of the law came to Jesus and asked him, "Which commandment is the first of all?"

What commandments do I remember and follow in my life? Which of the commandments are most important to me?

Jesus answered that the most important commandment was to love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength. He also said that the second important commandment is to love your neighbour as yourself.

What does it mean to love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength? What does it mean to love your neighbour as yourself? What can I do to live out my love for God today?

Today, Jesus tells us that to love God with all that we have is the most important thing for us to do. Therefore, it is so important for us to learn more about God and understand Him better, so that we love Him more completely. We pray for the grace of the Holy Spirit, that we may be able to follow the example of the saints in loving God and each other with all our heart, soul, mind and strength.

Say together as a family:

"Lord Jesus, you came down from heaven that we might have life in your name. You ask us to believe and to put our hope in you. We know that you love us and watch over us always. May we continue to grow in our faith and follow you, especially in times of trouble."



- Someone who educates or trains others






