SPEECH By Sr Rose Wong, Superior General SSFS at the COMBINED SSFS JUBILEE CELEBRATION

My dear Jubilarians, we are Franciscans, let us continue to 'SPEAK' to the world through our way of life that is connected with and to God, so that people can see the greatness of His Truth, what He can do to our lives, and they will search for the right things that can make them feel more contentment within, more peaceful and happier to live. Our community life that embraced the examples and teachings of Christ should prove to every family that it is possible to build the Domestic Church as God wishes. God has given us the best way to live, and He has offered to us freely. It depends on how much we can accept His free gift.

Our path is not only meaningful and enjoyable, but challenging. At times it is quite difficult to carry the cross as a gift of love towards God and humanity. But, it is worthwhile to encounter hardships, because that is the only way we can unite our sufferings with Christ. We need divine eyes to see the glory behind the cross. Apart from that, God will gradually purify our inner-self and make us free inwardly. These experiences will bring everlasting peace, and happiness into our lives, which no worldly things and worldly pleasure can offer us. Even Covid-19 will not be able to take away this peace, and no fear will enter us if our hearts have Him. The Lord has granted us countless blessings along our journey. His goodness and fulfilling experiences that we have encountered along the journey, give us the grace and strength to commit our lives to Him until today, and even beyond. These are the wonderful deeds that the Lord has done in our lives, and I am most happy to share with you all tonight.

On behalf of all my fellow religious Sisters, I would like to wish you all a Joyous and Blessed Christmas in advance. May we welcome the newborn Saviour to be born in our hearts and let every part of our being be united with Him.
