### **SCRIPTURE REFLECTION**

Invite someone to read Luke 6: 17, 20-26. Later, reflect on the questions given together as a family, and share your responses with one another. (If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding).

- 1. Jesus says that those who are poor, hungry or are weeping now will become happy? What is Jesus teaching us though this message today, especially since we ourselves may not really like to be poor, hungry or to weep?
- 2. Why is Jesus saying that those who are rich, satisfied or are laughing now will become unhappy?
- 3. What meaningful action will I or we do as a family this coming week or month to bring a smile or a sense of happiness to someone we know is poor, lonely or suffering?

## Some thoughts on today's scripture

The kingdom of God is mysterious because it is God's plan at work silently in our lives and in human history. From the Gospel passage today, however, we become aware of some of the people who will be in the Kingdom - the poor and the hungry will be there. So will those who weep, and also those who are mistreated, the persecuted, the outcasts of the earth will also be included. It is amazing! Those whom people consider to be at the lowest level of society will be blessed and will be rejoicing and leaping for joy at God's goodness to them

Jesus is not asking us to seek out poverty, unhappiness or suffering. He wants us to realise that God always holds a brighter promise for us if we trust and depend on him. He calls and challenges us seek him and to follow him and never remain in a situation where we think we have everything and done everything. Jesus wants more from us!
