

#### **INTRODUCTION**

This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the scripture readings of the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent. As we have just celebrated the Feast of the Annunciation of the Lord on 25<sup>th</sup> March, it is a good time to reflect on our relationship with God and with others around us.

#### **HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL**

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

#### WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent.

#### **OPENING PRAYER**

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of each one gathered here in your presence today. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for bringing us the gift of life and faith. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Peace, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



#### **SCRIPTURE REFLECTION**

Invite someone to read **Luke 15: 1-3, 11-32**. Then, as a family reflect on the questions given below and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

#### Time of reflection and response:

When they saw the tax collectors and sinners going to Jesus, the Pharisees and the scribes complained. 'This man welcomes sinners and eats with them.'

Then Jesus told them the parable of the prodigal son.

What happens when I choose to do what I like instead of doing what God wants?

How do I respond when I experience hardships and difficulties in my life?

What do I do when I realize that I have done something bad?

What is my attitude towards those who have done something that is not good or that I do not like?

How does God want me to treat these people?

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that God our Father loves us very much and will always forgive us for the bad things we do when we turn back to Him. He also wants us to be kind to each other, because we are all the children He loves.

We pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, so that we can learn to love and forgive each other as God our Father loves and forgives us.

#### Say together as a family:

"Lord Jesus, you came down from heaven that we might have life in your name. You ask us to believe and to put our hope in you. We know that you love us and watch over us always. May we continue to grow in our faith and follow you, especially in times of trouble."


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### **FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES**






# An Angel Visits Mary
