

#### INTRODUCTION

This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the scripture readings of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter. It is also Divine Mercy Sunday, and we specially pray to God for mercy and forgiveness of our sins today.

#### **HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL**

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

### WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter.

### OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of each one gathered here today. We ask for your mercy and forgiveness, especially for the times we have doubted You. Please help us to grow in faith and love for You. Holy Spirit, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



#### **SCRIPTURE REFLECTION**

Invite someone to read **John 20:19-31**. Then, as a family, reflect on the questions given below and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

### Time of reflection and response:

The doors were closed in the room where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews. Jesus came and stood among them. He said to them, 'Peace be with you.', and showed them his hands and his side. 'As the Father sent me, so am I sending you.'

In times of fear and uncertainty, what is my response? How can I receive the peace of Jesus in these times?

Thomas, one of the Twelve, was not with them. When the disciples told him about Jesus, he refused to believe. Eight days later, Jesus appeared to them again and said, 'Peace be with you.' Then he said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand; put it into my side. Doubt no longer but believe.' Thomas replied, 'My Lord and my God!'

Why did Thomas refuse to believe the other disciples? What might cause me to doubt God's love and power in my life?

Jesus said to him, 'You believe because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe.'

What can I do today to increase my faith and trust in God?

From the reading this week, we can see that it is not easy to believe in Jesus, especially in times of great fear and uncertainty. However, Jesus is truly risen, and he comes into the closed doors of our hearts, wishing us peace and asking us to believe in him. We pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and for the grace to believe even when we cannot see.

#### Say together as a family:

"Lord Jesus, you came down from heaven that we might have life in your name. You ask us to believe and to put our hope in you. We know that you love us and watch over us always. May we continue to grow in our faith and follow you, especially in times of trouble."

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

# Seeing Is Believing




