

INTRODUCTION

Dear parents and guardians. This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the gospel reading of 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time.

HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time.

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we have gathered here in the name of Jesus. Help us to always be ready to be send by Jesus to serve you. Holy Spirit, guide us during this lesson. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read **Luke 10: 1-12, 17-20 (or Luke 1-9)**. Later, reflect on the questions given together as a family, and share your responses with one another. (If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding).

Time for reflection and discussion:

The message entrusted to the disciples by Jesus is peace and the nearness of the kingdom of God'. This same message of peace and justice, forgiveness and healing, and the Good News of God's kingdom, has been entrusted to the Church down the centuries. Now it is our turn to witness to it.

What a great responsibility and privilege the Lord has bestowed on each of us to carry, together with others, the message of God's love and mercy to the world. Let us ask him therefore to give us the wisdom, courage and strength to carry on his ministry.

St. Teresa of Avila reminds us why we must carry on his ministry to the world through her prayer:

'Christ has no body on earth but yours; no hands but yours; no feet but yours. Yours are the eyes through which the compassion of Christ looks out to the world. Yours are the feet with which he is to go about doing good. Yours are the hands with which he is to bless others now.'

What do you think St. Teresa was saying to us through her prayer?

Jesus is preparing his disciples for mission. He leaves them in no doubt about the challenges, obstacles and dangers which will await them. They will succeed, however, because the power of God is working with them. Accordingly, 'the seventy return with joy'.

Do I experience that joy when I do what the Lord wants?

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

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


