INTRODUCTION

This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the scripture readings of the 22^{nd} Sunday in Ordinary Time.

HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 22nd Sunday of Ordinary Time.

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of each one gathered here today. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for bringing us the gift of life and faith. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Peace, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read **Luke 14: 1, 7-14**. Then, as a family reflect on the questions given below and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

Time of reflection and response:

Jesus had gone for a meal at the house of a Pharisee, and told the guests a parable, because he saw how they picked the places of honour. He said, "When you are invited to a feast, do not go to the place of honour, for the host may come and tell you to give up your seat to another guest more distinguished than you. Instead, go to the lowest place, so when the host comes and tells you to move up, everyone will see you honoured.'

Why do you think the guests wanted to sit at the place of honour? What are some of the honours we look for in our lives today? Why do you think Jesus told his listeners to avoid the place of honour and go to the lowest place instead?

Then Jesus said to the host, "When you give a feast, do not invite those who can repay you by inviting you in return. Instead, invite those who cannot pay you back, for you will receive your reward on the last day."

Why do you think Jesus told his host to invite those who cannot pay him back? What do you think is the reward that they will receive on the last day?

Today, Jesus teaches us to avoid being proud and arrogant, or doing things to receive praise and reward from others. Instead, he tells us to be humble in our actions, so that we may receive a greater honour and reward on the last day. Therefore, let us ask the Holy Spirit to continue to guide us and show us how to be humble and pleasing in God's sight.

Say together as a family:

"Lord Jesus, you came down from heaven that we might have life in your name. You ask us to believe and to put our hope in you. We know that you love us and watch over us always. May we continue to grow in our faith and follow you, especially in times of trouble."
