## **INTRODUCTION**

This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the scripture readings of the  $26^{th}$  Sunday in Ordinary Time.

### **HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL**

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

# WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time.

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of each one gathered here today. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for bringing us the gift of life and faith. Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Peace, guide us during this family gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



## **SCRIPTURE REFLECTION**

Invite someone to read **Luke 16: 19-31**. Then, as a family reflect on the questions given below and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding.

# Time of reflection and response:

Jesus told the Pharisees a parable of a very rich man and a poor man named Lazarus, who lay outside the rich man's gate. Lazarus was covered with sores, and longed to eat the scraps that fell from the rich man's table.

Do you know anyone who is like Lazarus? Do you know anyone who is like the rich man? What happened when Lazarus died? What happened when the rich man died?

When the rich man asked for water, Abraham told him that Lazarus was now being comforted after many hardships in his life, and that there was a great gulf between them and the rich man, so that no one could cross over even if they wanted to.

Why do you think the rich man is in hell while Lazarus is beside Abraham?

Then the rich man asked for Lazarus to go and warn his family, so that they would not end up in hell with him. But Abraham said that if they would not listen to Moses and the prophets, they would not believe even if someone were to come back from the dead.

What do you think the rich man's family would do if they saw Lazarus?

In the reading today, Jesus tells the story of a rich man and a poor man. At that time, many people, including the Pharisees, believed that people were poor because they were bad and sinful, while rich people were blessed by God. This parable shows us that we should not judge people by whether they are rich or poor, but by how well they have listened and carried out the Word of God in their lives. Therefore, may the Holy Spirit continue to guide us as we listen to God's Word and help us grow in our love and care for others.

# Say together as a family:

"Lord Jesus, you came down from heaven that we might have life in your name. You ask us to believe and to put our hope in you. We know that you love us and watch over us always. May we continue to grow in our faith and follow you, especially in times of trouble."




