INTRODUCTION

Dear parents and guardians. This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the gospel reading of 27th Sunday of Ordinary Time.

HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 27th Sunday of Ordinary Time.

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we have gathered here in the name of Jesus. Help us to have complete faith in You and to trust You. Holy Spirit, guide us during this lesson. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read Luke 17: 5-10. Later, reflect on the questions given together as a family, and share your responses with one another. (If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding).

Time of reflection and response:

Jesus draws attention to the greatness hidden in something very small, that is a mustard seed. We may feel that we are "small", but God is always ready to empower those who truly follow him to do great things. God can work through us, beyond all our hopes and dreams, when we surrender our lives to Him and remain humble.

Let us join the apostles and pray constantly and say to Jesus daily, 'Lord, increase my faith'. Let us listen with the same openness and wonder to Jesus' encouraging reply: it's enough for my faith to be as small as a mustard seed and I can do great things for God!

How often do I think I am unable to do great things for God because I lack faith? What is Jesus telling me today?

Jesus also warns us against the seeking credit for our good deeds. The servant has to realise that his or her duty is to serve the master and not expect the master to show gratitude or praise him or her. In the same way, we have to pray for the grace to see ourselves as the servant who tries not to see him or herself as superior to his master.

After I have done a good action for others - how often do I feel proud or pleased with myself? How often do I say, "I am only a servant who serves God who is my Master?"

Say this prayer:

Lord, you fill me with your unlimited love, and you invite me to share that love with a needy world. Let it be my joy to do that. That is my greatness joy to serve in love. Amen.




The Mustard Seed
