INTRODUCTION

Dear parents and guardians. This material has been prepared to provide families an opportunity to gather and spend time reflecting and discussing about the gospel reading of 2nd Sunday of Advent.

HOW TO USE THE MATERIAL

This document contains activities that members of the family may complete individually (just the children), in pairs (with parental assistance), or as an entire family. It would be helpful to print a hard-copy, so that members of your family may carry out different activities at the same time.

WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 2nd Sunday of Advent.

OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we have gathered here in the name of Jesus. Thank you for reminding us that the Season of Advent is a time to prepare for your coming into our lives in a new way. Holy Spirit, guide us during this gathering. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read Matthew 3: 1-12. Later, reflect on the questions given together as a family, and share your responses with one another. (If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding).

Time of reflection and response:

- 1. What can we learn about the character of John the Baptist from today gospel passage?
- 2. What is the message that God wants to give us during the Season of Advent through John the Baptist?

John the Baptist did not go the biggest cities or the capital city Jerusalem to take his message. Instead, he preached in the wilderness, that is, in the desert. Why? This is where God had called him to do his ministry. The desert is a dry, lonely and dangerous place. John has to reply totally on God for his daily food and protection.

The message he preached was not his own but came from God. This is why many people went out from the city to the desert to listen to him. The people were willing to travel far and suffer hardships to do so. They were willing to sacrifice because they believed the message John was teaching was important. God's Word is powerful. It inspires and changes people's hearts.

The mission of John the Baptist was to point people to Christ. It was to prepare their hearts for the coming Messiah. His desire was that that more people would follow Jesus. He laboured his whole life, but not for himself. He didn't care about being popular. He didn't care about his own reputation. He didn't care about hanging on to his own followers. His mission was all about Jesus.

Our mission, like John the Baptist, is to point people to Christ. Our mission is to reflect the light of Christ to a dark world. We have to tell people that Jesus has come and that He is coming again. We want the people around us to be ready when He does. Also, we learn from John that wherever God calls us to share His words, we have to do it faithfully and He will use us to accomplish His purposes.


